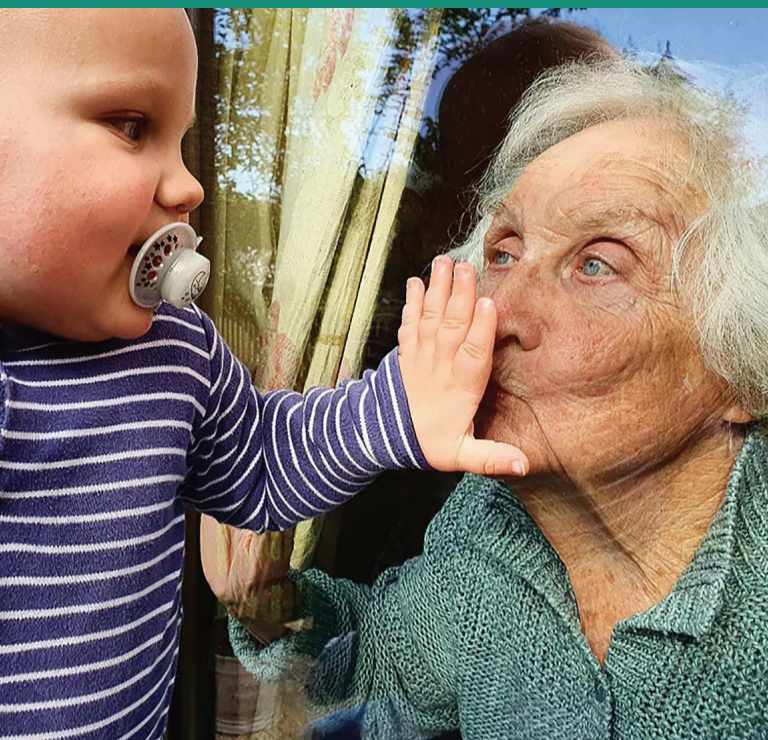

HAVE YOU BEEN DENIED ENTRY AT A CARE FACILITY DUE TO COVID CONCERNS?

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) have incorporated visitation rights into federal law. Facilities which fail to comply with these rules are at risk of losing their CMS funding. The resource sheet can be found here: halovoice.org/visitation-rights-during-covid-19-pdf/

REACH OUT TO YOUR STATE'S DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND/OR LONG TERM CARE OMBUDSMAN OFFICE.

Staff at these offices work to advocate for residents of long-term care facilities, and to investigate and resolve complaints.

FILE A COMPLAINT WITH THE OFFICE OF CIVIL RIGHTS.

The Office of Civil Rights (OCR) is a federal agency that investigates complaints of discrimination. Your complaint must be filed in writing by fax, e-mail, mail or online.
